Then, they toured Rumania as a part of a missionary journey and cultural representation of the Czech Republic abroad together with the new Czech ambassador. They also performed in the L'Hôtel national des Invalides in Paris in 2007 and in Rigas Domes, the Riga Cathedral in Latvia in 2008. Vladimír Roubal has been working as the director of Ecclesiastic music of the Royal Canonry of Premonstratensians in Strahov, Prague. Their CD „Organ of Sychrov, Organ of Antonín Dvořák” is a lovely rendition of Anatonín Dvořák’s music.
